As a pitcher you always submit a bottleneck/problem/challenge that is relevant to you. As a healthcare professional you have experienced this problem, or as a caretaker you have seen this problem, or as a citizen, patient, ex-patient or client you have experienced this problem and you would like to solve it to improve your health. This is what we call a hands-on expert.
